1	Technical excellence and/or industry leadership	Explain how the nominee has made a positive impact or contribution to the tunnelling industry through leading projects or teams, on project sites, technical excellence and/or industry leadership.	33%
	Tunnelling, mining, civil, geotechnical, design, supplier, construction or other	Max Word Count: 450 words	
2	Participation in industry knowledge-sharing	Explain how the nominee is active in industry knowledge-sharing, e.g., safety and quality shares, conference speaker, delivering technical presentations, lessons learnt, best practice, technical papers or publications, or active in other industry initiatives such as working groups or wellbeing programs.  Max Word Count: 450 words	33%
3	Promoting and representing the industry by mentoring and/or advocating opportunities in the fields of tunnelling, engineering or STEM	Explain how the nominee is a role model by, for example, mentoring and/or promoting the tunnelling industry.  Max Word Count: 300 words	20%
4	Professional body participation: ATS, Engineers Australia, NZTS or other	explain the nominee's involvement or impact on a professional body e.g. through committees, volunteering etc. or any other participation that the nominee may feel is relevant.  Max Word Count: 150 words	7%

5	Supporting information (not compulsory but will be evaluated)	For example, letters of endorsement (not compulsory), media or appearance on podcasts, video etc.	7%
